ZAASO has recently started an Education Programme in Willey School.

Through this programme we hope to educate the children of Zanzibar about animal welfare, correct animal husbandry and about the Zoonotic diseases found in Zanzibar.

ZAASO aim is to educate the next generation in how to care for animals in order to reduce the number of animal cruelty cases seen across the Island.

Alongside teaching in the class room we would like to set up visits for each class to come to ZAASO and observe the Saturday Clinic so they get first hand knowledge of the kind of illnesses their animals can get and the importance of having them treated correctly.

Teaching Aims :- Animal care – appropriate food, shelter and affection

Vaccinations – Rabies is common in Zanzibar and many people are unaware of what it is and how it can be passed to humans and the importance of vaccinating their animal against rabies – ZAASO vaccinates for free so the children are encouraged to bring their animals to clinic to have them vaccinated.

Diseases – ticks and worms are a huge problem and are often left untreated, we teach the children the importance of treating these illnesses for both the animal and for themselves

The children are encouraged to participate in activities to assess their knowledge of animal welfare
