




## ITALIA 🖈




### ERIC & AMINA



Our "orphans" are those who cannot be rehomed; trauma and abuse count for the overwhelming majority of these. Fortunately, some of our permanent residents are sponsored or co-sponsored, but our "orphans" are those who are not, and who are in need of a caring sponsor or sponsors.
